Executive Summary

On September 1, 2004, the Eastern School District was established through the amalgamation of four former school districts: Avalon East, Avalon West, Burin Peninsula and Vista. The Eastern School District is now the largest school district in the province both in terms of student enrolment and number of schools. The District maintains approximately 5.2 million square feet of floor space in 125 schools with approximately 44,000 students and 4,000 teaching and support staff. School facilities have an average age of 36 years. Six of these schools are over 50 years old.

As part of its governance function, Eastern School Board has a responsibility to ensure a wise investment of resources. The Board's goal is to ensure that students are housed in buildings which provide safe, healthy and accessible learning environments and that as many students as possible have access to the broadest and highest quality programs and services it can provide. The delivery of high-quality educational programs is the most important objective in the Board's Multi-Year Plan. All decisions regarding reconfigurations and/or closures have been evaluated in terms of meeting this objective.

During the past several months, planning committees, led by senior district staff, have held 17 public consultation meetings and met with numerous school councils. Through in excess of 200 oral presentations, written submissions, e-mails and submissions through the District's website, parents/guardians, school councils, teachers, students and other stakeholders have had an opportunity for input. This consultation process provided an opportunity whereby all stakeholders could provide feedback on the future direction of education in the District.

This Multi-Year Plan has been developed following the Board's Planning Considerations (student enrolment, grade level configurations, facilities, and transportation), and using data collected through internal research and feedback from school administrators, as well as input received through the public consultation process. Within this plan, the Eastern School Board is demonstrating its commitment to providing educational programs to children using a model of community and neighborhood schools.

This model brings many challenges to Eastern School District - small, rural schools with challenges around program delivery; and larger, urban schools with large class sizes. While the challenges are great, Eastern School Board is committed to continuing to work with all communities and school councils of this District to ensure our students receive the highest possible educational opportunities.

The Board did not take lightly, any decision to recommend a school for closure, and recognized the importance of finding a balance between protecting community/neighborhood schools, and ensuring that our students are receiving the highest possible educational opportunities in safe, healthy and accessible learning environments. This plan reflects the Board's attempt to find this balance.

The Board also gave extensive consideration to those schools which have been designated by the Department of Education as being Necessarily Existent Small Schools (NESS). In some cases, it was determined that, in the foreseeable future, these schools will be able to continue to offer student programs comparable to those that have been offered over the past several years, and that there is widespread community support for these schools. In other cases, however, while there is community support for the schools, enrolments have dropped dramatically since the schools first received the designation, to a level that student programming has been negatively impacted. In such instances, the Board has recommended a plan which will allow the students access to much improved facilities, with a greater number of their peers, and access to a broader range of school programs, services, and activities.

This plan highlights a number of future considerations for the Eastern School Board and in particular, the critical need for further planning in the St. John's, Mount Pearl, and Paradise and Conception Bay South areas. While this plan addresses the more immediate needs, the objective of a second planning phase will be to focus on growth areas where new facilities may be required, and to consider the re-alignment of feeder systems around the concept of community and neighborhood schools and/or discrete K-12 systems. Where there are currently high levels of bussing of students across school catchment areas, the Board's vision is to work with school communities and the public in an effort to streamline this into more clearly defined neighborhood/community school systems for the St. John's, Mount Pearl, Paradise and Conception Bay South area of our District.

Through a collaborative and consultative approach, the Eastern School Board will continue to focus on planning activities which seek to ensure the highest possible educational opportunities for all students

Planning Considerations

Through this school reorganization and restructuring process, the goal of the Eastern School Board was to provide for educational programs and school facilities where all students receive the highest quality educational experiences possible, thus assisting them in achieving to the best of their potential.

The Board recognized the following planning considerations as factors contributing to its ability to offer quality student programming:

- **Student Enrolment:** Student enrolment trends have a significant impact on a school's ability to offer quality programs, due to corresponding relationship to course offerings, teacher allocations, and support staff assistance.
- **Grade Level Configurations:** Various grade level configurations can optimize program offerings and the availability of resources for students.
- **Facilities:** The age and condition of buildings, the potential for expansion, enrolment capacity, availability of regular and specialty instructional spaces, and accessibility are critical issues to educational delivery.
- **Transportation:** Many transportation factors must be considered, including the distance and travel time, road conditions, and Government regulations on student bussing.

Each of these factors was considered, within the context of the Board's primary focus – student program availability – as part of the Board's Multi-Year Plan for school reorganization and alignment. The Board also recognizes that many of the recommendations contained in this plan will require the Government's support for financing school construction, extensions and renovations.

In addition to these factors, the Board also considered those schools which held the status of a Necessarily Existent Small School (NESS). The Schools Act, 1997, Section 77 (2) permits the Minister to designate a school to "...be maintained and operated because of isolation or because the students cannot reasonably be accommodated in another school." The Eastern School District, prior to the development of this plan, had 16 schools with NESS status, and this was a further factor considered as part of this process.

Future Directions

The Board's Draft Multi-Year Plan has established the framework for the future direction of the District. Many complex and challenging issues, however, remain to be resolved.

- **Phase II Planning – St. John's, Mount Pearl, Paradise and Conception Bay South:** Due to the scope and complexity of the issues emanating from restructuring, the Board will conduct a further study of facility capacity and student attendance zones in the St. John's, Mount Pearl, Paradise and Conception Bay South areas. This review will identify growth areas where new facilities may be required and consider the re-alignment of feeder systems around the concept of community and neighborhood schools. Throughout this review, a consultation process will be established to provide all stakeholders an opportunity for input.
- **Transition Teams:** The Eastern School District will establish Transition Teams to work with schools affected by this plan. These Transition Teams, in consultation with school administrations, will work with parents/guardians, school councils and teachers in an effort to facilitate a smooth transition process.
