Advanced Placement Psychology 4220 Distance Learning Program

This school year the Eastern School District will be offering a pilot distance learning program in Advanced Placement Psychology 4220. This program will be offered after school hours and will require at least one hour of “live” on line class time one evening each week. It will be available to a maximum of twenty students throughout the district and it will commence on the week of October 15, 2007 and conclude no later than the week of May 19, 2008.

Student Requirements/Costs:

- Full time, level III student in Eastern School District.
- Maintaining academic standing with an overall average of at least 75%.
- Internet access
- **Payment of \$255.00 due at information session prior to the beginning of program.** This payment covers the AP Psychology Text (Myers, 8th Ed., approx. \$125.00 including tax), and the College Board Exam Application (approx. \$130.00).

There is no registration fee for this program.

The program will follow Eastern School District policy and Department of Education guidelines for advanced placement courses. Students will receive two high school credits if they obtain at least a level 2 on the College Board Exam. If students obtain at least a level 3 on the College Board Exam they will receive an exemption for Psychology 1000 and credit for Psychology 1001 at Memorial University.

Furthermore, the program will be offered in a compressed time frame and will require an extensive amount of independent work. As a result, participants must be maintaining an overall average of at least 75%. The registration form will require a signature from the participant's school principal to verify that the student meets this academic requirement.

A maximum of twenty participants will be accepted. The Eastern School District reserves the right for approving registrations.

Prior to the beginning of the program, an information session with district personnel will occur for all participants to review the delivery of the program and answer any questions or concerns. Full payment of \$255.00 will be required at this session.
