## REGISTRATION FOR LATE FRENCH IMMERSION

The Eastern School District currently offers a Late French Immersion Program beginning in Grade 7. The program is intended for any student who considers fluency in French to be a desired goal. Students develop a high level of competency in the French language by studying part of the curriculum in French, with approximately 70% of the curriculum taught in French in Grades 7 and 8, decreasing to approximately 50% taught in French in Grade 9 and approximately 30% French instruction in Levels I-III. Content specific and other educational outcomes are achieved as through the English program. French Immersion studies serve to achieve the Essential Graduation Learnings, and enable students to function in French upon completion of high school.
