



## **Twelve ESD schools to Receive Provincial Government Funding for Safe and Caring Schools Projects**

Twelve schools in the Eastern School District will receive funding from the Provincial Government to help make their schools safe, respectful environments, with each school receiving a maximum of \$500.

Schools submitted project proposals which were reviewed by a provincial advisory committee for the Safe and Caring Schools initiative. Projects which best reflected the goals of the initiative and best contribute to a safe and caring learning environment were chosen for funding.
